

Covered over-the-counter medications

Prudential covers some over-the-counter (OTC) prescription medication. The following OTC medications* are covered the same as generics. This means they have the same coinsurance and copay amounts. Just bring your prescription and the OTC medication to the pharmacy counter. The amount you pay for the OTC item should reflect your plan costs.
