- Condoms – Female
- Condoms – Male
- Contraceptive Films
- Contraceptive Foams
- Emergency Birth Control
- Oral Birth Control Pills

## Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) preventive medications

For members who have a higher chance to become infected with HIV but have not yet been infected, this medication is available at a \$0 cost share.
